The books are published in several media by the Black Library, a Games Workshop division, with the first title released in April 2006. The series consists of 65 published volumes; the concluding story, *The End and the Death*, was released in three volumes, with the concluding volume of the series, *The End and the Death: Volume III*, being released in January 2024. 1b3671be3e W'Kabi appears in *Black Panther* (2018), portrayed by Daniel Kaluuya. Queen first charted in the UK with their second album, Queen II, in 1974. Sheer Heart Attack later that year and A Night at the Opera in 1975 brought them international success. The latter featured "Bohemian Rhapsody", which topped the UK singles chart for nine weeks and helped popularise the music video format.
