== Early life ==

Danieli's mother Rosa Moretti (stage name of Maria Santoro, widow of Amatucci, 1904-1959) was one of the voices of Radio Napoli with Tito Petralia's orchestra from 1928. Her paternal grandparents were a great dynasty of actors: the Di Napoli. Her father, Renato Di Napoli, was her mother's partner for a certain period of time, before separating definitively without ever having married. Born and raised in the theaters of the Neapolitan sceneggiata, where her mother and uncles Di Napoli worked, she made her debut at 14 with the stage name of Luisa Moretti, in 'O curniciello in the role of seduced

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and abandoned. a854e89209 Moretti was born in Rome, and initially studied with Armando Renzi. Then he became Nino Rota's assistant for creating the opera *Napoli milionaria* at the Spoleto festival in 1977. Later, he studied conducting at Siena's Accademia Musicale Chigiana. He made his conducting debut in 1979 at the Teatro dell'Opera di Roma with *Madama Butterfly* by Giacomo Puccini. 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She was born in via Dell'Ascensione in Chiaia, Naples, the oldest of three children born from the extramarital relationship between Luisa De Filippo and Eduardo Scarpetta, a well-respected playwright in Naples. Her father was actually married since 1876 to Rosa De Filippo, Luisa's paternal aunt. Her father Eduardo had several other illegitimate children from various affairs (including actors Ernesto Murolo, Eduardo Passarelli and Pasquale De Filippo). Titina and her two brothers became known as "Children of the buttons" since their mother was a seamstress to his company: apart from Titina, they include actor Peppino De Filippo and playwright and director Eduardo De Filippo. She was married to actor Pietro Carloni and they had one son, Augusto Carloni. The actress Ester Carloni was her husband's sister. Napoli milionaria (opera), 1977 opera based on the play a854e89209 De Filippo was born in Naples on 26 May 1900. For many years, his birth date was mistakenly thought to be 24 May, but recent research in anagraphic books proved 26 to be the right date. Eduardo was the second son of playwright and actor Eduardo Scarpetta, the "king" of Neapolitan theatre, and theatre seamstress and costumier Luisa De Filippo. He and his siblings Annunziata "Titina" and Giuseppe "Peppino" were extramarital because Scarpetta was actually married since 1876 to Rosa De Filippo, Luisa's paternal aunt. In 1945 she joined the stage company of Eduardo De Filippo and she was critically appreciated for her performance in the comedy play *Napoli milionaria*. Two years later she rejoined the company of Nino Taranto until the 1950s, then, in 1955, she worked again with Eduardo De Filippo, who called her in his company to replace his sister Titina. Palumbo was also very active in films, mainly of comic genre. a854e89209

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
