Active learning " Kuh and his coworkers identified Active learning is "a method of learning in which students are actively or experientially involved in the learning process and where there are different levels of active learning, depending on student involvement. identified High-Impact practices (HIPs) as " a Specific set of practices that tended to lead to meaningful experiences for students. " Bonwell & Eison (1991) states that "students participate [in active learning] when they are doing something besides passively listening. Scheyvens, Griffin, Jocoy, Liu, & Bradford (2008) further noted that "by utilizing learning strategies that can include small-group work, role-play and simulations, data collection and analysis, active learning is purported to increase student interest and motivation and to build students 'critical thinking, problem. In its most commonly used sense, dharma refers to an individual's moral responsibilities or duties; the dharma of a farmer differs from the dharma of a soldier, thus making the concept of dharma dynamic.
