He was born in Wangen, Württemberg. He studied first at the Royal Academy in Munich under Robert von Langer, remaining in that city from 1815 to 1823. Among his productions there were two idyllic works, a "Saint Sebastian" and a "Madonna and Child", altar-piece for his native town. In 1823 the painter went to Rome, where he remained until 1826, studying especially the works of Raphael. He became successful as a fresco painter, and, on his return to Württemberg, the

king made him court painter and commissioned him to decorate the Royal Villa of Schloss Rosenstein. During some of this time he studied music under Francesco Pasquale Ricci. Sambuca was passionate about music, writing in his diaries about a concert he attended by Georg Joseph Vogler. The memoir also discusses other aspects of his personal life, such as his friendship with other writers including Bruce Chatwin, Paul Theroux, Bill Buford, and Martin Amis, as well as public figures such as Alan Yentob.
