The Egyptians invented and used many simple machines, such as the ramp and the lever, to aid construction processes. The wheel was used for a number of purposes, but chariots only came into use after the Second Intermediate Period. Ancient Egypt civilizations, including the Hyksos, the Kushites, the Assyrians, the Persians, and, most notably, the Greeks and then the Romans. It emerged from prehistoric Egypt around 3150 BC (according to conventional Egyptian chronology), when Upper and Lower Egypt were amalgamated by Menes, who is believed by the majority of Egyptologists to have been the same person as Narmer. The end of ancient Ancient Egypt was a cradle of civilization concentrated along the lower reaches of the Nile River in Northeast Africa. The history of ancient Egypt unfolded as a series of stable kingdoms interspersed by the "Intermediate Periods" of relative instability. These stable kingdoms existed in one of three periods: the Old Kingdom of the Early Bronze Age; the Middle Kingdom of the Middle Bronze Age; or the New Kingdom of the Late Bronze Age ac5fef1e73
