Eros (concept) S. Lewis Eros (, US: ; from Ancient Greek ἔρως (érōs) 'love, desire') is a concept in ancient Greek philosophy referring to sensual or passionate love, from which the term erotic is derived. The Protestant philosopher C. S. Lewis uses the term to describe the universal desire that drives all innate needs (of the id), which according to Freud is identical to Plato's conception. Eros has also been used in philosophy and psychology in a much wider sense, almost as an equivalent to "life energy".
