Chevrolet Corvette (C8) The C8 was announced in April 2019, and the coupe made its official debut on July 18, 2019, in Tustin, California. It is the first rear mid-engine Corvette since the model's introduction in 1953, differing from the traditional front mid-engine design started in 1963.
