The PMO is the source of documentation, guidance, and metrics on the practice of project management and execution. Project management – discipline of planning, organizing, securing, managing, leading, and controlling resources to achieve specific goals. A project is a temporary endeavor with a defined beginning and end (usually time-constrained, and often constrained by funding or deliverables), undertaken to meet unique goals and objectives, typically to bring about beneficial change or added value. The temporary nature of projects stands in contrast with ongoing business operations. In 1939 the term "project management office" was used in a publication for the first time. The 1800s project office was a type of national governance of the agricultural industry. The objective of project management is to produce a complete project which complies with the client's objectives. In many cases, the objective of project management is also to shape or reform the client's brief to feasibly address the client's objectives. Once the client's objectives are established, they should influence all decisions made by other people involved in the project- for... Originally intended to be a politically neutral and analytical organization, the 1970 restructuring transformed the OBM from a simple budget office to one of the most powerful institutions directly under the president's control... Darling & Whitty (2016) note that the definition of the PMO's function has evolved over time: Microsoft Project was the company's third Microsoft Windows-based application. Within a few years after its launch, it became the dominant PC-based project management software. From 2015 to 2020 it was the most popular application for project management according to Project Management Zone.
