Less than 2% of the rural populations Energy use and development in Africa varies widely across the continent, with some African countries exporting energy to neighbors or the global market, while others lack even basic infrastructures or systems to acquire energy. From 2001 to 2005, GDP for over half of the countries in Sub Saharan Africa rose by over 4. 5% annually, while generation capacity grew at a rate of 1. 2%. Energy development has not kept pace with rising demand in developing regions, placing a large strain on the continent's existing resources over the first decade of the new century. individuals have access to the electrical grid, and of those, 75% come from the richest two quintiles in overall income

Air filter Filters containing an adsorbent or catalyst such as charcoal (carbon) may also remove odors and gaseous pollutants such as volatile organic compounds or ozone. Air filters are used in applications where air quality is important, notably in building ventilation systems and in engines. He concluded additional inductance was required to prevent amplitude and time delay distortion of the transmitted signal.
