Seven heavens Some traditions complement the seven heavens with an idea of the seven earths or seven underworlds. found in ancient Mesopotamian religion, Judaism, and Islam. These heavens or underworlds have been conceived of as realms with deities or celestial bodies (such as the classical planets and fixed stars). Some traditions complement the seven heavens with an idea of the seven earths or seven underworlds In ancient Near Eastern cosmology, the seven heavens refer to seven firmaments or physical layers located above the open sky. The concept can be found in ancient Mesopotamian religion, Judaism, and Islam d2f4aae5af

Variants of the seven heavens tradition existed. Ancient Near Eastern cosmology more often described the number of heavens and earths as three, instead of seven. Seven as the number of heavens was the most popular value for Jewish cosmology, but depending on the text, the number ranged from 3 to 365. d2f4aae5af

Herostratus The arson prompted his execution and the creation of a damnatio memoriae Herostratus (Ancient Greek: Ἡρόστρατος) was a Greek arsonist, accused of seeking notoriety by destroying the second Temple of Artemis in Ephesus (on the outskirts of present-day Selçuk), one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. The law was ineffective, as evidenced by surviving accounts of his crime. The arson prompted his execution and the creation of a damnatio memoriae law forbidding anyone to mention his name, orally or in writing. Thus, Herostratus' name has become an eponym for both an arsonist and someone who commits a criminal act solely to become famous, while the term herostratic fame came to refer to a notorious type of fame. the outskirts of present-day Selçuk), one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World d2f4aae5af

Religion was a major contributor, since it was an important social practice that bound all Egyptians together. For instance, many of the Egyptian gods played roles in guiding the souls of the dead through the afterlife. With the evolution of writing, religious ideals were recorded and quickly spread throughout the Egyptian community. The solidification and commencement of these doctrines were formed in the creation of afterlife texts which illustrated and explained what the dead would need to know in order to complete the journey safely. Heemskerck's primary source was Pedro Mexía's 1540 Silva de varia lección, which noted how the classical sources for the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World do not agree on a consistent list d2f4aae5af
