Grade inflation 50. Grade inflation is often equated with lax academic standards. 2% in 2001–04. For this to be grade inflation, it is necessary to demonstrate that the quality of work does not deserve the high grade. For example, the following quote about lax standards from a Harvard University Grade inflation (also known as grading leniency) is the general awarding of higher grades for the same quality of work over time, which devalues grades. 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Phonics Phonics is also sometimes used as part of the process of teaching Chinese people (and foreign students) to read and write Chinese characters, which are not alphabetic, using pinyin, which is alphabetic. To use phonics is to teach the relationship between the sounds of the spoken language (phonemes), and the letters (graphemes) or groups of letters or syllables of the written language. It has been called "the single most important document in New York City's development," and the plan has been described as encompassing the "republican predilection for control and balance. "
