

The Presidents Visual Encyclopedia

The idea of the encyclopedia was presented to His Royal Highness Prince Muqrin bin Abdulaziz, Head of General Intelligence and Honorary President of the Saudi Health Informatics Society, who in turn conveyed the idea to the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz, who kindly approved it and allocated a budget for the project. This was announced at the Saudi e-Health Conference held in Riyadh in 2010.

Commission

The encyclopedia was created in 1995 by Edward N. Zalta, with the explicit aim of providing a dynamic encyclopedia that is updated regularly, and so does not become dated in the manner of conventional print encyclopedias.

Establishment

Printed for 245 years, the Britannica was the longest-running in-print encyclopaedia in the English language. It was first published between 1768 and 1771 in Edinburgh, Scotland, in weekly instalments that came together to form

three volumes. At first, the encyclopaedia grew quickly in size from edition to edition. The second edition expanded to 10 volumes, and by its fourth edition (1801–1810), it had expanded to 20 volumes. Since the beginning of the twentieth century, its size, measured as total word count, has remained roughly steady at about 40 million words. Britannica's has had several notable contributors. The 9th (1875–1889) and 11th editions (1911) are considered landmark encyclopaedias for scholarship and literary style. Starting with the 11th edition and following its acquisition... project immediately elicited a response from Harvard alumnus Alfred St. Vrain Carpenter, A.B...
