Oxygen therapy Supplemental oxygen can also refer to the use of oxygen enriched air at altitude. Oxygen therapy is often useful in chronic hypoxemia caused by conditions such as severe COPD or cystic fibrosis. oxygen therapy has been shown to negatively impact a person's condition. It can also be given through bypassing the airway, such as in ECMO therapy. Oxygen can be delivered via nasal cannula, face mask, or endotracheal intubation at normal atmospheric pressure, or in a hyperbaric chamber. Acute indications for therapy include hypoxemia (low blood oxygen levels), carbon monoxide toxicity and cluster headache. It may also be prophylactically given to maintain blood oxygen levels during the induction of anesthesia. The central premise is that emotions influence cognition, motivate behavior, and are strongly linked to needs.
