

Pokemon Ruby Sapphire Official Strategy Guide

Pokémon Ruby and Sapphire They are the first installments in the third generation of the Pokémon video game series, also known as the "advanced generation". Remakes of the two games, titled Pokémon Omega Ruby and Alpha Sapphire, were released for the Nintendo 3DS worldwide in November. After years of Nintendo being the sole publisher of the franchise in all regions, The Pokémon Company co-published the games for the first time since the establishment of the joint-owned company in 1998.
