released as the lead single from *Halcyon* on 17 August 2012. *Halcyon* is the second studio album by English singer and songwriter Ellie Goulding, released on 5 October 2012 by Polydor Records. The album was recorded between 2011 and 2012, during promotion for her debut album, *Lights* (2010). It reached number one in the UK, New Zealand, and the top 10 in Canada, Germany and Switzerland.

In 2006, they performed to a growing fanbase at Download Festival as well as a sold-out concert at the London Astoria. Their debut studio album, *Take to the Skies*, was released in 2007 and reached number 4 in the Official UK Album Chart, and has since been certified gold in the UK.
