Generally, the musical work contains overtures, interludes and musical accompaniments, while the sung part can be in choir or solo, duet, trio, or various combinations, in different structures such as recitative or aria. There are various genres, such as classical opera, chamber opera, operetta, musical, singspiel, and zarzuela. History of opera In his following works he gave predominance The history of opera has a relatively short duration within the context of the history of music in general. Since then it has developed parallel to the various musical currents that have followed one another over time up to the present day, generally linked to the current concept of classical music. It appeared in 1597, when the first opera, *Dafne*, by Jacopo Peri, was created. D'Annunzio. It was followed by operas such as *Debora e Jaele* (1922), *Fra Gherardo* (1928) and *Lo straniero* (1930) 33c1b9b57e

== Race structure == 33c1b9b57e The exact origins are not known, but it is theorized to be based on a folk song of the late 19th century, sung by female workers (*mondine*) of the paddy fields in Northern Italy in protest against harsh working conditions. There is little evidence of the song being used during World War II, with the current partisan version becoming widespread only after it ended. Versions of "Bella ciao" continue to be sung worldwide as a hymn of resistance against Nazism, fascism, injustice and oppression. 33c1b9b57e Battisti released 18 studio albums from 1969 to 1994, with a significant portion of this catalogue translated into Spanish (various albums), English (one album), French (two albums), and German (one album). He was known to be an extremely reserved artist, performing only a small number of live concerts during his career. In 1978 he announced that he would speak to the public only through his musical work, limiting himself to the recording of studio albums and disappearing from the public scene. 33c1b9b57e
