Synthetic phonics It helps significantly with word-reading Synthetic phonics, also known as blended phonics or inductive phonics, is a method of teaching English reading which first teaches letter-sounds (grapheme/phoneme correspondences) and then how to blend (synthesise) these sounds to achieve full pronunciation of whole words. small groups, and teaching classes of students; and is effective from kindergarten onward, the earlier the better

Emergent literacies awareness when learning to read. It signals a belief that, in literate society, young children—even one- and two-year-olds—are in the process of becoming literate. Specific Emergent literacy is a term that is used to explain a child's knowledge of reading and writing skills before they learn how to read and write words. Due to its importance, many preschool, kindergarten and higher grade levels have phonological awareness programs. Through the support of parents, caregivers, and educators, a child can successfully progress from emergent to conventional reading

Phonological awareness Phonological awareness is an important and reliable predictor of later reading ability and has, therefore, been the focus of much research. awareness skills. Phonological awareness skills in the preschool and kindergarten years also strongly predict how well a child will read in the school Phonological awareness is an individual's awareness of the phonological structure, or sound structure, of words

Reading supports the strong synergy between reading (decoding) and spelling (encoding), especially for children in kindergarten or grade one and elementary school students Reading is the process of taking in the sense or meaning of symbols, often specifically those of a written language, by means of sight or touch

Whole language "reading or literacy experiences" as well as phonemic awareness from pre-kindergarten to grade 1, and phonics and word recognition from grade 1 to grade Whole language is a philosophy of reading and a discredited educational method originally developed for teaching literacy in English to young children. It is based on the premise that learning to read English comes naturally to humans, especially young children, in the same way that learning to speak develops naturally. However, researchers such as Reid Lyon say reading is "not a natural process", and many students, when learning to read, require direct instruction in alphabetic coding, phonemic awareness, phonics, spelling, and comprehension skills. The method became a major model for education in the United States, Canada, New Zealand, and the UK in the 1980s and 1990s, despite there being no scientific support for the method's effectiveness 53411e231f

Phonics kindergarten education and care is free and compulsory for children aged 3–6. It can be used with any writing system that is alphabetic, such as that of English, Russian, and most other languages. Phonics is also known as the alphabetic principle or the alphabetic code. Pre-school Phonics is a method for teaching reading and writing to beginners. Phonics is also sometimes used as part of the process of teaching Chinese people (and foreign students) to read and write Chinese characters, which are not alphabetic, using pinyin, which is alphabetic. To use phonics is to teach the relationship between the sounds of the spoken language (phonemes), and the letters (graphemes) or groups of letters or syllables of the written language.
