Aerodynamics The term aerodynamics is often used synonymously with gas dynamics, the difference being that "gas dynamics" applies to the study of the motion of all gases, and is not limited to air. The assumption of a fluid continuum allows problems in aerodynamics Aerodynamics (from Ancient Greek ἀήρ (aḗr) 'air' and δυναμική (dunamikḗ) 'dynamics') is the study of the motion of air, particularly when affected by a solid object, such as an airplane wing. The formal study of aerodynamics began in the modern sense in the eighteenth century, although observations of fundamental concepts such as aerodynamic drag were recorded much earlier. guide the choice between statistical mechanics and the continuous formulation of aerodynamics. Most of the early efforts in aerodynamics were directed toward achieving heavier-than-air flight. John von Neumann The physics of quantum mechanics was thereby reduced to the mathematics of Hilbert spaces and John von Neumann (von NOY-mən; Hungarian: Neumann János Lajos ['nɔjmon 'ja:nɔf 'lɔjɔf]; December 28, 1903 – February 8, 1957) was a Hungarian and American mathematician, physicist, computer scientist and engineer. He was a pioneer in building the mathematical framework of quantum physics, in the development of functional analysis, and in game theory, introducing or codifying concepts including cellular automata, the universal constructor and the digital computer. His analysis of the structure of self-replication preceded the discovery of the structure of DNA. on the Hilbert space associated with the quantum system. Von Neumann had perhaps the widest coverage of any mathematician of his time, integrating pure and applied sciences and making major contributions to many fields, including mathematics, physics, economics, computing, and statistics c5ea59fad2

Josiah Willard Gibbs the "del" notation that is widely used today in electrodynamics and fluid mechanics. His work on the applications of thermodynamics was instrumental in transforming physical chemistry into a rigorous deductive science. In other mathematical work, he re-discovered the "Gibbs phenomenon" Josiah Willard Gibbs (; February 11, 1839 - April 28, 1903) was an American mechanical engineer and scientist who made fundamental theoretical contributions to physics, chemistry, and mathematics. Together with James Clerk Maxwell and Ludwig Boltzmann, he created statistical mechanics (a term that he coined), explaining the laws of thermodynamics as

consequences of the statistical properties of ensembles of the possible states of a physical system composed of many particles. Gibbs also worked on the application of Maxwell's equations to problems in physical optics. As a mathematician, he created modern vector calculus (independently of the British scientist c5ea59fad2
