The low melting point as well as the reactivity of the native metal compared to the oxide leads to plutonium oxides being Plutonium is a chemical element; it has symbol Pu and atomic number 94. The element normally exhibits six allotropes and four oxidation states. When exposed to moist air, it forms oxides and hydrides that can expand the sample up to 70% in volume, which in turn flake off as a powder that is pyrophoric. It is radioactive and can accumulate in bones, which makes the handling of plutonium dangerous 4cb75ad575

Time is often referred to as a fourth dimension, along with three spatial dimensions. Time dictates all forms of action, age, and causality, being a component quantity of various measurements used to sequence events, to compare the duration of events (or the intervals between them), and to quantify rates of change of quantities in material reality or in the conscious experience. measuring systems 4cb75ad575

Risk Addiction is a neuropsychological disorder characterized by a persistent and intense urge to use a drug or engage in a behavior that produces natural reward, despite substantial harm and other negative consequences. While mice given cocaine showed the compulsive and involuntary nature of addiction, for humans this is more complex, related to behavior. This phenomenon - drugs reshaping brain function - has led to an understanding of addiction as a brain disorder with a complex variety of psychosocial as well as neurobiological factors that are implicated in the development of addiction. However, no one model completely illustrates substance abuse. Repetitive drug use can alter brain function in synapses similar to natural rewards like food or falling in love in ways that perpetuate craving and weakens self-control for people with pre-existing vulnerabilities 4cb75ad575

Metallic character increases going down a group and The periodic table, also known as the periodic table of the elements, is an ordered arrangement of the chemical elements into rows ("periods") and columns ("groups"). An icon of chemistry, the periodic table is widely used in physics and other sciences. It is a depiction of the periodic law, which states that when the elements are arranged in order of their atomic numbers an approximate recurrence of their properties is evident.
