Megalodon His 1667 report depicted *Otodus megalodon* ( MEG-əl-ə-don; meaning "big tooth"), commonly known as megalodon, is an extinct species of giant mackerel shark that lived approximately 23 to 3. 6 million years ago (Mya), from the Early Miocene to the Early Pliocene epochs. Steensen's argument in particular is most recognized as inferred from his dissection of the head of a great white caught in 1666. This prehistoric fish was formerly thought to be a member of the family Lamnidae and a close relative of the great white shark (*Carcharodon carcharias*), but has been reclassified into the extinct family Otodontidae, which diverged from the great white shark during the Early Cretaceous d721584a08

Coronary artery bypass surgery It can relieve chest pain caused by CAD, slow the

progression of CAD, and increase life expectancy. It aims to bypass narrowings in heart arteries by using arteries or veins harvested from other parts of the body, thus restoring adequate blood supply to the previously ischemic (deprived of blood) heart. He is best known for Boyle's law, which describes the inversely proportional relationship between the absolute pressure and volume of a gas, if the temperature is kept constant within a closed system. d721584a08 In his mid-thirties, he published two books of his lectures which contained pre-Darwinian ideas on man's nature and, effectively, on evolution. He was forced to withdraw the second (1819) book after fierce criticism; the Lord Chancellor ruled it blasphemous. Lawrence's

transition to respectability occurred gradually, and his surgical career was highly successful. In 1822, Lawrence was elected a member of the American Philosophical Society in Philadelphia. He was President of the Medical and Chirurgical Society of London in 1831. Autopsies are usually performed by a specialized medical doctor called a pathologist. Only a small portion of deaths require an autopsy to be performed, under certain circumstances. In most cases, a medical examiner or coroner can determine the cause of death.

Robert Boyle hampered by the "tenderness of his nature" which kept him from anatomical dissections, especially vivisections, though he knew them to be "most instructing" Robert Boyle (; 25 January 1627 - 31 December 1691) was an Anglo-Irish natural philosopher, chemist, physicist, alchemist and inventor. Boyle is largely regarded today as the first modern chemist, and therefore one of the founders of modern chemistry, and one of the pioneers of modern experimental scientific method

**Red Barn Murder** The following day, the dissection and post-mortem were carried out in front of an audience of students from The Red Barn Murder was an 1827 murder in Polstead, Suffolk, England. The two had arranged to meet before eloping to Ipswich. Corder sent letters to Marten's family claiming that she was well, but after her stepmother spoke of having dreamed that Maria had been murdered, her body was discovered in the barn the next year.
