Intelligence quotient DIF analysis measures such specific items on a test alongside An intelligence quotient (IQ) is a total score derived from a set of standardized tests or subtests designed to assess human intelligence. with the same latent abilities give different answers to specific questions on the same IQ test. For modern IQ tests, the raw score is transformed to a normal distribution with mean 100 and standard deviation 15. The resulting fraction (quotient) was multiplied by 100 to obtain the IQ score. This results in approximately two-thirds of the population scoring between IQ 85 and IQ 115 and about 2 percent each above 130 and below 70. Originally, IQ was a score obtained by dividing a person's estimated mental age, obtained by administering an intelligence test, by the person's chronological age 77de5db529
