The various definitions... For educators and researchers, reading is a multifaceted process involving such areas as word recognition, orthography (spelling), alphabeticity, phonics, phonemic awareness, vocabulary, comprehension, fluency, and motivation.

Aggression a study done in human subjects showed that prefrontal-amygdala connectivity is modulated by endogenous testosterone during social emotional behavior. In Aggression is behavior aimed at opposing or attacking something or someone. In humans, aggression can be caused by various triggers. Human aggression can be classified into direct and indirect aggression; while the former is characterized by physical or verbal behavior intended to cause harm to someone, the latter is characterized by behavior intended to harm the social relations of an individual or group. For example, built-up

frustration due to blocked goals or perceived disrespect. Though often done with the intent to cause harm, some might channel it into creative and practical outlets. It may occur either reactively or without provocation f9130ceb7f

Intellectual giftedness 5 percent of the population—that is, IQs above 130. There is no generally agreed definition of giftedness for either children or adults, but most school placement decisions and most longitudinal studies over the course of individual lives have followed people with IQs in the top 2. These consequences sometimes include stigmatizing and social exclusion. It is a characteristic of children, variously defined, that motivates differences in school programming. Definitions of giftedness also vary across cultures. If a teacher expects more success academically from specific students, those students are prone to displaying behavior and work ethic that will set them Intellectual giftedness is an intellectual ability significantly higher than average and is also known as high potential. It is thought to persist as a trait into adult life, with various consequences studied in longitudinal studies of giftedness over the last century f9130ceb7f

Variably known as English as a foreign language (EFL), English as a second language (ESL), English for speakers of other languages (ESOL), English as an additional language (EAL), or English as a new language (ENL), these terms denote the study of English in environments where it is not the dominant language. Programs such as ESL are designed as academic courses to instruct non-native speakers in English proficiency, encompassing both learning in English-speaking nations and abroad f9130ceb7f
