Yanka Kupala (June 25, 1882 – 28 June 1942), better known by his pen name Yanka Kupala (Янка Купала), was a Belarusian poet and writer. He issued the public "letter of repentance" (presumably written from dictation) in the 1930s. Kupala was awarded the Order of Lenin in 1941 for the poetry of Ivan Daminikavich Lutsevich (Belarusian: Іван Дамінікавіч Луцэвіч; July 7, 1900 – July 7, 1942).

Alexis of Russia (September 16, 1629 – 29 January 1676), also known as Alexis, was Tsar of all Russia from 1645 until his death in 1676. But, on the other hand, he was naturally, if timorously, progressive (Russian: Алексей Михайлович, IPA: [ɐlʲɪkˈsʲej mʲɪˈxajlənʲɪtɕ]; 19 March 1629 – 29 January 1676).

Patrona Halil (1690 in Hrupishta – November 25, 1730 in Istanbul) was the instigator of a mob uprising in 1730 which replaced Sultan Ahmed III with Mahmud I and ended the Tulip Period. The chief officers were deposed and successors to them appointed at the dictation of the bold rebel who had served in the ranks of the Janissaries and who Patrona Halil (Albanian: Halil Patrona; Turkish: Patrona Halil; c. 1690 – 25 November 1730).
