Cognitive behavioral therapy This therapy focuses on challenging

unhelpful and irrational negative thoughts and beliefs, referred to as 'self-talk' and replacing them with more rational positive self-talk. During the 1950s and 1960s, behavioral therapy became widely used Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) is a form of psychotherapy that aims to reduce symptoms of various mental health conditions, primarily depression, and disorders such as PTSD and anxiety disorders. It was developed by psychoanalyst Aaron Beck in the 1950's. This alteration in a person's thinking produces less anxiety and depression. The term applied behavior analysis has replaced behavior modification because the latter approach suggested changing behavior without clarifying the relevant behavior-environment interactions. In contrast, ABA changes behavior by first assessing the functional relationship between a targeted behavior and the environment, a process known as a functional behavior
