Employment To categorize a worker as an independent contractor rather than an employee, an independent contractor must agree with the Employment is a relationship between two parties regulating the provision of paid labour services. Employees in some sectors may receive gratuities, bonus payments or stock options. Usually based on a contract, one party, the employer, which might be a corporation, a not-for-profit organization, a co-operative, or any other entity, pays the other, the employee, in return for carrying out assigned work. In some types of employment, employees may receive benefits in addition to payment. Employees work in return for wages, which can be paid on the basis of an hourly rate, by piecework or an annual salary, depending on the type of work an employee does, the prevailing conditions of the sector and the bargaining power between the parties. hired as independent contractors.
