It marked a major advance in tractor design, distinguished by light weight, small size, manoeuvrability and versatility. By far his most successful design, it was manufactured from 1946 until 1956, and was commonly known as the Little Grey Fergie. In many parts of the world the TE20 was the first tractor to be affordable to the average farmer and was small and light enough to replace the draft horse and manual labour.
