Following World War I, the Imperial Japanese Navy General Staff began to reconsider submarine warfare as an element of fleet strategy. Before the war, the Imperial Japanese Navy regarded submarines as useful only for short-range coastal point defense. However, based on the success of the Imperial German Navy in deploying long-range cruiser submarines for commerce raiding during World War I, Japanese strategists came to realize the potential for using submarines for long-range reconnaissance, as well as in a war of attrition against an enemy fleet approaching Japan. Procurement of a large, long-range Japanese submarine was authorized in fiscal year 1918 under the Eight-six fleet program, under the

The Labour Party, led by wartime Deputy Prime Minister Clement Attlee, won the 1945 post-war general election in an unexpected landslide and formed their first ever majority government. Labour governed until 1951 and granted independence to India in 1947. Most of the other major overseas colonies became independent in the late 1950s and early 1960s. The UK collaborated closely with the United States during the Cold War after 1947, and in 1949 they helped form NATO as a military alliance against the spread of Soviet Communism. af0d7550b8 Initial fighting on New Britain took place around the western end of the island in December 1943 and January 1944, with US forces landing and securing bases around Arawe and Cape Gloucester. This was followed by a further landing in March 1944 around Talasea, after which little fighting took place between the ground forces on the island. In October 1944, the Australian 5th Division took over from the US troops and undertook a landing at Jacquinot Bay the following month, before beginning a limited offensive to secure a defensive line across the island between Wide Bay and Open Bay behind which they contained the numerically superior Japanese forces for the remainder of the war. The Mustang was designed to use the Allison V-1710 engine without an export-sensitive turbocharger or a multi-stage supercharger, resulting in limited high-altitude performance. Post-war Britain (1945–1979) Many historians describe this era as the "post-war consensus", emphasising how both the Labour and Conservative Parties until the 1970s tolerated or encouraged nationalisation, strong trade unions, heavy regulation, high taxes, and a generous welfare state. The Bank of England, railways, heavy industry and coal mining were all nationalised. Economic recovery was slow, housing was in short supply and bread was rationed along with many necessities in short supply. Britain was a strong anti-Soviet factor in the Cold War and helped found NATO in 1949. India, Pakistan, Burma and Ceylon gained independence. It was an "age of austerity". After Britain emerged victorious from the Second World War, the Labour Party under Clement Attlee won the 1945 general election in a landslide, applying Keynesian Economics, and created a comprehensive welfare state, with the establishment of the National Health Service giving free healthcare to all British citizens, and other reforms to social welfare. Unlike the others, the most controversial issue was nationalisation of steel, which was profitable. American loans and Marshall Plan grants kept the economy afloat

The Germans had rapidly overwhelmed France and the Low Countries in the Battle of France, leaving Britain to face the threat of invasion by sea. The German high command recognised the difficulties of a seaborne attack while the Royal Navy controlled the English Channel and the North Sea. The primary objective of the German forces was to compel Britain to agree to a negotiated peace settlement. The Labour Party came to power following its unexpected landslide victory in the July 1945 general election... Following a long debate and initial scepticism, the United Kingdom joined the European Economic Community along with the Republic of Ireland and Denmark on 1 January 1973. Immigration from the British Empire and Commonwealth laid the foundations for the multicultural society in today's Britain, while traditional Anglican and other denominations of Christianity declined. == Events ==
