An outline is used to present the main points (in sentences) or topics (terms) of a given subject. An outline may be used as a drafting tool of a document, or as a summary of the content of a document or of the knowledge in an entire field. If an organizational level in an outline is to be sub-divided, it shall have at least two subcategories, although one subcategory is acceptable on the third and fourth levels, as advised by major style manuals in current use. Each item in an outline may be divided into additional sub-items.
