The fundamental objects of study in algebraic geometry are algebraic varieties, which are geometric manifestations of solutions of systems of polynomial equations. Examples of the most studied classes of algebraic varieties are lines, circles, parabolas, ellipses, hyperbolas, cubic curves like elliptic curves, and quartic curves like lemniscates and Cassini ovals. These are plane algebraic curves. A point of the plane lies on an algebraic curve if its coordinates satisfy a given polynomial equation. Basic questions involve... Equal squares can tile the plane edge-to-edge in the square tiling. Square tilings are ubiquitous in tiled floors and walls, graph paper, image pixels, and game boards. Square shapes are also often seen in building floor plans, origami paper, food servings, in graphic design and heraldry, and in instant photos.

A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number. p . However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers

are smaller than 4. If p really is prime, it will always answer yes, but if p is not prime, it will answer no. A prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. If so, it answers yes and otherwise it answers no.
