The positive response generated by Thompson's performance would be an important influence on the show's creative direction in its formative years. While Thompson made only a handful of recordings late in his life, his cantankerous and eccentric personality and his fiddle skills have made him one of the best-known icons of early country music. He is best remembered as the first performer to play on Nashville's Grand Ole Opry (then called the WSM Barn Dance), appearing with founder and host George D

One of Thompson's best-known musical associations was his membership in Paul Desmond's "Toronto Quartet" from 1974 to 1976, along with Ed Bickert and Jerry Fuller. Thompson also worked for several years in the 1970s and 1980s with guitarist Jim Hall. Thompson was also a member of Rob McConnell's Boss Brass for more than two decades starting in the late 1960s. Born to actors Eric Thompson and Phyllida Law, Thompson was educated at Newnham College, Cambridge, where she became a member of the Footlights troupe, and appeared in the comedy sketch series *Alfresco* (1983–1984). In 1985, she starred in the West End revival of the musical *Me and My Girl*, which was a breakthrough in her career. In 1987, she came to prominence for her performances in two BBC series, *Tutti Frutti* and *Fortunes of War*, winning the BAFTA TV Award... Thompson first gained prominence in the late 1960s as the lead guitarist and songwriter for the folk rock group Fairport Convention, which he had co-founded in 1967. After departing the group in 1971, Thompson released his debut solo album *Henry the Human Fly* in 1972. The next year, he formed a duo with his wife Linda Thompson, which produced six albums, including the critically acclaimed *I Want to See the Bright Lights Tonight* (1974) and *Shoot Out the Lights* (1982). After the dissolution of the duo, Thompson revived his solo career with the release of *Hand of Kindness* in 1983. He has released eighteen solo studio albums.
