A great deal of specialized hardware and software has been developed, with the displays of most devices being driven by computer graphics hardware

How a fragment is combined with the data already in the frame buffer depends on various settings. In a typical case, a fragment may be discarded if it is further away than the pixel which is already at that location (according to the depth buffer).
