Pulp magazine Pulps were the successors to the penny dreadfuls, dime novels, and short-fiction magazines of the 19th century. The typical pulp magazine was 128 pages, 7 inches (18 cm) wide by 10 inches (25 cm) high, and 0.3 cm) thick, with ragged, untrimmed edges. In contrast, magazines printed on higher-quality paper were called "glossies" or "slicks". F.
