Organizational culture influences how people interact, how decisions are made (or avoided), the context within which cultural artifacts are created, employee attachment, the organization's competitive advantage, and the internal alignment of its units. Corporate structure However, there is a great diversity in corporate forms, as enterprises range from single company to multi-corporate conglomerate. Many businesses have a CEO and a Board of Directors, usually composed of the directors of each department, potentially with the addition of one or more non-executive directors. requirements, or add and remove jobs. The four main corporate structures are Functional, Divisional. Common departments include Marketing, Finance, Operations management, Human Resource, and IT. There are also company presidents, vice presidents, and CFOs. These five divisions represent the major departments within a publicly traded company, though there are often smaller departments within autonomous firms

Organizational culture Business management concept Gareth Morgan (business theorist) - Organizational theorist Inclusive business Inclusiveness - Form of social disadvantage and Organizational culture encompasses the shared norms, values, and behaviors—observed in schools, not-for-profit groups, government agencies, sports teams, and businesses—reflecting their core values and strategic direction. The term corporate culture emerged in the late 1980s and early 1990s. Alternative terms include business culture, corporate culture and company culture. It was used by managers, sociologists, and organizational theorists in the 1980s

individuals in organizations (micro-level) The book particularly describes the organization metaphorically as (1) machines, (2) organisms, (3) brains, (4) cultures, (5) political systems, (6) psychic prisons, (7) flux and transformation, and (8) instruments of domination.

Corporate DNA It is a metaphor based on the biological term DNA, the molecule that encodes the genetic instructions in living organisms. Chester Barnard recognized that individuals behave differently when acting in their organizational role than when acting separately from the organization. Organizational behavior researchers study the behavior of individuals primarily in their organizational roles. One of the main goals of organizational behavior research is "to revitalize organizational theory and develop a better conceptualization..."

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
