Sundial The equation of time was A sundial is a horological device that tells the time of day (referred to as civil time in modern usage) when direct sunlight shines by the apparent position of the Sun in the sky. The style is the time-telling edge of the gnomon, though a single point or nodus may be used. The style must be parallel to the axis of the Earth's rotation for the sundial to be accurate throughout the year. As the Sun appears to move through the sky, the shadow aligns with different hour-lines, which are marked on the dial to indicate the time of day. The gnomon may be a rod, wire, or elaborately decorated metal casting. After the invention of good clocks, sundials were still considered to be correct, and clocks usually incorrect. The gnomon casts a broad shadow; the shadow of the style shows the time. In the narrowest sense of the word, it consists of a flat plate (the dial) and a gnomon, which casts a shadow onto the dial. was not used 4478be94eb

Escapement watches and clocks that gives impulses to the timekeeping element and periodically releases the gear train to move forward, advancing the clock's hands. The impulse action transfers energy to the clock's timekeeping element (usually a pendulum or balance wheel) to replace the energy lost to friction during its cycle and keep the timekeeper oscillating. This regular periodic advancement moves the clock's hands forward at a steady rate. The escapement is driven by force from a coiled spring or a suspended weight, transmitted through the timepiece's gear train. At the same time. The An escapement is a mechanical linkage in mechanical watches and clocks that gives impulses to the timekeeping element and periodically releases the gear train to move forward, advancing the clock's hands. Each swing of the pendulum or balance wheel releases a tooth of the escapement's escape wheel, allowing the clock's gear train to advance or "escape" by a fixed amount 4478be94eb
