These vessels branch off the efferent arterioles of juxtamedullary nephrons (those nephrons closest to the medulla). They enter the medulla, and surround the loop of Henle. Whereas the peritubular capillaries surround the cortical parts of the tubules, the vasa recta go into the medulla and are closer to the loop of Henle, and leave to ascend to the cortex. Earlier editions were called *Anatomy: Descriptive and Surgical*, *Anatomy of the Human Body* and *Gray's Anatomy: Descriptive and Applied*, but the book's name is commonly shortened to, and later editions are titled, *Gray's Anatomy*. The book is widely regarded as an extremely influential work on the subject.
