However, unlike a A quantum computer is a (real or theoretical) computer that uses quantum mechanical

phenomena in an essential way: a quantum computer exploits superposed and entangled states and the (non-deterministic) outcomes of quantum measurements as features of its computation. Ordinary ("classical") computers operate, by contrast, using deterministic rules. Any classical computer can, in principle, be replicated using a (classical) mechanical device such as a Turing machine, with at most a constant-factor slowdown in time—unlike quantum computers, which are believed to require exponentially more resources to simulate classically. Information systems can be defined as an integration of components for collection, storage and processing of data, comprising digital products that process data to facilitate decision making and the data being used to provide information and contribute to knowledge. Michigan Terminal System The University of Michigan shut down its MTS system for The Michigan Terminal System (MTS) is one of the first time-sharing computer operating systems. computing systems, typically Unix for servers and various Mac, PC, and Unix flavors for clients. Created in 1967 at the University of Michigan for use on

IBM S/360-67, S/370 and compatible mainframe computers, it was developed and used by a consortium of eight universities in the United States, Canada, and the United Kingdom over a period of 33 years (1967 to 1999)

An ILS is usually made up of a relational database, software to interact with that database, and two graphical user interfaces (one for patrons, one for staff). Most ILSes separate software functions into discrete programs called modules, each of them integrated with a unified interface. Examples of modules might include:
