Bio-MEMS have considerable overlap, and is sometimes considered synonymous, with lab-on-a-chip (LOC) and micro total analysis systems (μ TAS). "Wireless Recording Bio-MEMS is an abbreviation for biomedical (or biological) microelectromechanical systems. Bio-MEMS is typically more focused on mechanical parts and microfabrication technologies made suitable for biological applications. In this definition, lab-on-a-chip devices do not strictly have biological applications, although most do or are amenable to be adapted for biological purposes. Passive tags are powered by energy from the RFID reader's interrogating radio waves. Active tags are powered by a battery and thus can be read at a greater range from the RFID reader, up to hundreds of meters. 4902c96439

"Millimetro: MmWave retro-reflective tags for accurate, long range localization" Radio-frequency identification (RFID) uses electromagnetic fields to automatically identify and track tags attached to objects. This number can be used to track inventory goods. When triggered by an electromagnetic interrogation pulse from a nearby RFID reader device, the tag transmits digital data, usually an identifying inventory number, back to the reader.
