Aside from the raw analysis step, it also involves database and data management aspects, data pre-processing, model and inference considerations, interestingness metrics, complexity considerations, post-processing of discovered structures, visualization, and online updating. Data mining is an interdisciplinary subfield of computer science and statistics with an overall goal of extracting information (with intelligent methods) from a data set and transforming the information into a comprehensible structure for further use. It bridges the gap from applied statistics and artificial intelligence (which usually provide the mathematical background) to Data mining is the process of extracting and finding patterns in massive data sets involving methods at the intersection of machine learning, statistics, and database systems. Robust statistics One motivation is to produce statistical methods that are not unduly affected by outliers. robust statistics, and are now the preferred solution, though they can be quite involved to calculate. in Bayesian Data Analysis (2004) Robust statistics are statistics that maintain their properties even if the underlying distributional assumptions are incorrect. Robust statistical methods have been developed for many common problems, such as estimating location, scale, and regression parameters. For example, robust methods work well for mixtures of two normal distributions with different standard deviations; under this model, non-robust methods like a t-test work poorly. Another motivation is to provide methods with good performance when there are small departures from a parametric distribution. Gelman et al 0fb997439a
