Chromium(III) sulfate Three chromium(III) sulfates are well characterized: Anhydrous chromium(III) Chromium(III) sulfate usually refers to the inorganic compounds with the formula $\text{Cr}_2(\text{SO}_4)_3 \cdot x(\text{H}_2\text{O})$, where x can range from 0 to 18. It is commonly used in tanning leather. These salts are usually either violet or green solids that are soluble in water. Hexavalent chromium Hexavalent chromium compounds can be carcinogens (IARC Group 1), especially if airborne and inhaled where they can cause lung cancer. contaminated by chromium-based leather tanning waste products (as opposed to the non-toxic process of vegetable tanned leather) has been shown to have entered Hexavalent chromium (chromium(VI), Cr(VI) , chromium 6) is any chemical compound that contains the element chromium in the +6 oxidation state (thus hexavalent). It has been identified as carcinogenic, which is of concern since approximately 136,000 tonnes (150,000 tons) of hexavalent chromium were produced in 1985 01c75f04c8
