Quarter glass Quarter glass is also sometimes called a valence window. Only some cars have them. front door opening (examples include the Buick Encore, Chevrolet Lumina APV, Toyota Prius, Opel Astra J, Mitsubishi Endeavor, Fiat Grande Punto, Suzuki Quarter glass (or quarter light) on automobiles and closed carriages may be a side window in the front door or located on each side of the car just forward of the rear-facing rear window of the vehicle. In some cases, the fixed quarter glass may set in the corner or "C-pillar" of the vehicle

General Motors U platform The minivans were divided into three generations, 1990–1996, 1997–2005 and 2005-current. North American sales ended in 2009, but Chinese production continues. The vehicles in this generation included: Chevrolet Lumina APV ("APV" was dropped from the model name in 1994) Oldsmobile Silhouette Pontiac The U-platform (or U-body) is a front wheel drive minivan and crossover SUV platform from General Motors produced since 1990. Marking the transition of the mid-size Chevrolet range to front-wheel drive, the Celebrity succeeded the rear-drive Chevrolet Malibu line. Initially marketed between the Citation and the Impala within the Chevrolet model line, the Celebrity was later marketed between the Corsica and Caprice sedans.

The first ground-up redesign of the model lines since their introduction, designers added a further degree of divisional identity between the Plymouth Voyager, Dodge Caravan, and Chrysler Town & Country. Coinciding with the retirement of the Plymouth brand during 2001, this is the final generation marketed as the Plymouth Voyager. In a notable change, the cargo van was discontinued, with all examples sold as passenger vans
