Hugh Everett III American physicist who proposed the relative state interpretation of quantum mechanics. The quantum statistic becomes a measure of the branching of the universal wave function. Everett also helped found small companies specializing in contracts with the US government. Everett's theory dropped the wave function collapse postulate of quantum measurement theory, incorporating the observer in the same quantum state as the observation result. John von Neumann His analysis of the structure of self-replication preceded the discovery of the structure of DNA. He was a pioneer in building the mathematical framework of quantum physics, in the development of functional analysis, and in game theory, introducing or codifying concepts including cellular automata, the universal constructor and the digital computer. Von Neumann had perhaps the widest coverage of any mathematician of his time,

integrating pure and applied sciences and making major contributions to many fields, including mathematics, physics, economics, computing, and statistics. Von Neumann first proposed a quantum logic in his 1932 treatise *Mathematical Foundations of Quantum Mechanics*, where John von Neumann (von NOY-mən; Hungarian: Neumann János Lajos [ˈnɔjmɒn ˈjaːnoʃ ˈlɒjoʃ]; December 28, 1903 – February 8, 1957) was a Hungarian and American mathematician, physicist, computer scientist and engineer. development of quantum decoherence theories 786ed370b3
