Johnny A. was born in Malden, Massachusetts, of Greek heritage. Growing up in the Boston area, he became interested in music, starting with drums at the age six. Upon being exposed to The

Beatles in 1964 at the age of 11, Johnny's parents bought him a \$49 Lafayette Electronics guitar. He stated his last name, Antonopoulos, which is of Greek origin, was frequently mispronounced. "It's always been Johnny A. since age eight." 97ca55acdd After leaving the service in 1959, Taylor lived in Riverhead. His first major professional gig was as Maxine Brown's bandleader at the Apollo Theater and his first number one R&B hit single was "Funny". Taylor himself, often using the name Sammy Taylor, recorded for various labels including Capitol, Enjoy, and Atlantic Records. 97ca55acdd Hendrix moved to England in late 1966, after bassist Chas Chandler of the Animals became his manager. Within months, he formed the Jimi Hendrix Experience (with its rhythm section consisting of bassist Noel Redding and drummer Mitch Mitchell) and

achieved three UK top-ten hits: "Hey Joe", "Purple Haze", and "The Wind Cries Mary"....

album, "Back to the Egg". critic S. 35. Something Else. Victor "Old Siam, Sir" is a single written by Paul McCartney and released on Wings' 1979 album, Back to the Egg. Music writers have called his work on "Shapes of Things" groundbreaking, and cited its influence on the guitar playing of Paul McCartney and Jimi Hendrix. Several live Yardbirds

recordings with Beck and later with Jimmy Page have been released.

Shapes of Things It is built on musical elements contributed by several group members in three different recording studios in the US, and was the first Yardbirds composition to become a chart hit; when released as a single on 25 February 1966, the song reached number three in the UK and number eleven in the US. with Jimmy Page "Shapes of Things" is a song by the English rock group the Yardbirds. With its Eastern-sounding, feedback-laden guitar solo and environmentalist, antiwar lyrics, several music writers have identified it as the first popular psychedelic rock song. and cited its influence on the guitar playing of Paul McCartney and Jimi Hendrix
