So that if input A produces response X, and input B produces response Y, then input (A + B) produces response (X + Y)

Hugh Everett III In 1954, Everett took Methods of Mathematical Physics with Eugene Wigner, although he remained active in mathematics and presented a paper on military Hugh Everett III (; November 11, 1930 – July 19, 1982) was an American physicist who proposed the relative state interpretation of quantum mechanics. This influential approach later became the basis of the many-worlds interpretation (MWI). Everett's theory dropped the wave function collapse postulate of quantum measurement theory, incorporating the observer in the same quantum state as the observation result. Everett also helped found small companies specializing in contracts with the US government. The quantum statistic becomes a measure of the branching of the universal wave function
