The history of chemistry is intertwined with the history of thermodynamics, especially through the work of Willard Gibbs... a5c96a4770 In respiratory physiology, the partial pressure of a dissolved gas in liquid (such as oxygen in arterial blood) is also defined as the partial pressure of that gas as it would be undissolved in gas phase yet in

equilibrium with the liquid. This concept is also known as blood gas tension. In this sense, the diffusion of a gas liquid is said to be driven by differences in partial pressure (not concentration). In chemistry and thermodynamics, this concept is generalized... a5c96a4770

Partial pressure The symbol In a mixture of gases, each constituent gas has a partial pressure which is the notional pressure of that constituent gas as if it alone occupied the entire volume of the original mixture at the same temperature. concentrations in a gas mixture or as a solute in solution. The total pressure of an ideal gas mixture is the sum of the partial pressures of the gases in the mixture (Dalton's Law). This general property of gases is also true in chemical reactions of gases in biology a5c96a4770

An ABG test measures the blood gas tension values of the arterial partial pressure of oxygen (P_{aO_2}), and the arterial partial pressure of carbon dioxide (P_{aCO_2}), and the blood's pH. In addition, the arterial oxygen saturation (S_{aO_2}) can be determined. Such information is vital when caring for patients with critical illnesses or respiratory disease. Computational chemistry The complexity inherent in the many-body problem exacerbates the challenge of providing detailed descriptions of quantum mechanical systems. Computational chemistry is a branch of chemistry that uses computer simulations to assist in solving chemical problems. The importance of this subject stems from the fact that, with the exception of some relatively recent findings related to the hydrogen molecular ion (dihydrogen cation), achieving an accurate quantum mechanical depiction of chemical systems analytically, or in a closed form, is not feasible. It uses methods of theoretical chemistry incorporated into computer programs to calculate the structures and properties of molecules, groups of molecules, and solids.
