Appropriation (art) The use of appropriation has played In art, appropriation is the use of pre-existing objects or images with little or no transformation applied to them. Notable in this respect are the readymades of Marcel Duchamp. In the visual arts, "to appropriate" means to properly adopt, borrow, recycle or sample aspects (or the entire form) of human-made visual culture.
