Horse Humans began domesticating horses around 4000 BCE in Central Asia, and their domestication is believed to have been widespread by 3000 BCE. are names for different physical, occupational, and speech therapy treatment strategies that use equine movement. It belongs to the taxonomic family Equidae and is one of two extant subspecies of *Equus ferus*. These feral populations are not true wild horses, which are horses that have never been domesticated. There is an extensive, specialized vocabulary used to describe equine-related concepts, covering everything from anatomy. Horses in the subspecies *caballus* are domesticated, although some domesticated populations live in the wild as feral horses.
