In the United States, estimates of unemployment range from 39% to 85%. A 2021 report in the United Kingdom found 71% of autistic adults are unemployed. The rate of employment for autistic people is generally seen to be very low in the US and across the globe, but accurate measurement is rare, as studies often have small sample sizes and rely on self-reporting. Many autistic adults face significant barriers to full-time employment and have few career prospects despite the fact that approximately 50% of autistic individuals have a normal or high-normal IQ and no significant physical disabilities. In fact, autistic young adults are more likely to be unemployed than people with learning disabilities, intellectual disabilities, or speech/language impairment

Schizotypal personality disorder Those with the disorder often score high on measures for self-disorder. They frequently interpret situations as being strange or having unusual meanings for them; paranormal and superstitious beliefs are common.
