Astor Piazzolla Biographers Astor Pantaleón Piazzolla (Spanish: [pja'sola], Italian: [pjat'tsolla]; March 11, 1921 – July 4, 1992) was an Argentine tango composer, bandoneon player, and arranger. un loco" (Ballad for a madman) and Adiós Nonino (dedicated to his father), which he recorded many times with different musicians and ensembles. "La Bamba" has been covered by numerous other artists, most notably by Los Lobos, whose version was the title track of the soundtrack to the 1987 film *La Bamba*, a biopic about Valens; their version topped many charts in the same year. Singers and musicians Martinho da Vila, Emmanuel, Pete Escovedo... Recorded over a 16-day period at MGM Studios in Los Angeles, California, the album was an old wish of Regina, who always wanted to record a full album of Jobim's songs with him. This finally came true in 1974, when Elis was celebrating her 10th anniversary as an artist of Philips Records. The label approved the project as a gift for her.

The Composer of Desafinado Plays Released in 1963, the album features a dozen instrumentals arranged by Claus Ogerman, whose work would mark the beginning of a lifelong musical relationship with Jobim. The opening track "The Girl from Ipanema" is believed to be the second most recorded song in history behind The Beatles' "Yesterday," and a recording of the song by Astrud Gilberto and Stan Getz became a worldwide hit in 1964.
