SPARS Its purpose was to release male officers and enlisted men for sea duty by replacing them with women at shore stations. Stratton was appointed director of the Women's Reserve and given the rank of lieutenant commander. The Women's Reserve was established by law in November 1942 during World War II. As the Behind the Mast authors SPARS was the official nickname for the United States Coast Guard (USCG) Women's Reserve. The nautical acronym was derived from the USCG's motto, Latin: "Semper Paratus"—"Always Ready" (SPAR). She was later promoted to captain. earning petty officer ratings as yeoman and storekeepers—enlisted personnel were found in nearly every job classification. This same month, Dorothy C. The CCC was designed to supply jobs for young men and to relieve families who had difficulty finding jobs during the Great Depression in the United States. Roosevelt's New Deal that supplied manual labor jobs related to the conservation and development of natural resources in rural lands owned by federal, state, and local governments

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Georg Elser Elser was held as a prisoner for more than five years until he was executed at Dachau concentration camp less than a month before the surrender of Nazi Germany. Later, on the basis of his Swabian accent, Elser was identified by a storekeeper as the man to whom he had sold a "sound proofing insulation plate" to Johann Georg Elser (German: ['ge:ɔŋk 'ɛlzɐ] ; 4 January 1903 - 9 April 1945) was a German carpenter who planned and carried out an elaborate assassination attempt on Adolf Hitler and other high-ranking Nazi leaders on 8 November 1939 at the Bürgerbräukeller in Munich (known as the Bürgerbräukeller Bombing). It did not kill Hitler, who left earlier than expected, but it did kill 8 people and injured 62 others. Elser constructed and placed a bomb near the platform from which Hitler was to deliver a speech
