Aqueduct (bridge) A modern version of an aqueduct is a pipeline bridge. Large navigable aqueducts are used as transport links for boats or ships. The word is derived from the Latin aqua ("water") and ducere ("to lead"), therefore meaning "to lead water". Aqueducts must span a crossing at the same level as the watercourses on each end. The term aqueduct may also be used to refer to the entire watercourse, as well as the bridge. Roman aqueducts set a standard of engineering that was not surpassed for more Aqueducts are bridges constructed to convey watercourses across gaps such as valleys or ravines. Surface-supplied diving The primary advantages of conventional surface supplied diving are lower risk of drowning and considerably larger breathing gas supply than scuba, allowing longer working periods and safer decompression. This is different from scuba diving, where the diver's breathing equipment is completely self-contained and there is no essential link to the surface. Disadvantages are the absolute limitation on diver mobility imposed by the length of the umbilical, encumbrance by the umbilical, and high logistical. It is also nearly impossible for the diver to get lost. Hydraulic ram They specialised in water supply and sewerage systems worldwide A hydraulic ram pump, ram pump, or hydram is a cyclic water pump powered by hydropower. The hydraulic ram is sometimes used in remote areas, where there is both a source of low-head hydropower and a need for pumping water to a destination higher in elevation than the source. In this situation, the ram is often useful, since it requires no outside source of power other than the kinetic energy of flowing water. It takes in water at one "hydraulic head" (pressure) and flow rate, and outputs water at a higher hydraulic head and lower flow rate.
